Renovation Wave

- At least double the annual rate of renovation
- Over 220 million building units built before 2001
- EUR 275 billion per year
- 160 000 additional green jobs in construction by 2030
- 12-18 local jobs per million EUR

The EU construction industry ecosystem

- 9.6% of EU Gross Value Added (EUR 1 208 billion)
- 25 million jobs, 5.3 million firms
- 35.9% of waste generated (2018)
- Half of resources extracted

Renovation Wave: specific action

- Building Renovation Passports and a single digital tool unifying them, Smart Readiness Indicators, EPCs with Digital Building Logbooks
- EU framework for digital permits and recommending BIM in public procurement

- 2050 roadmap to reduce whole life cycle carbon in buildings
- Reviewing material recovery targets and supporting the internal market for secondary raw materials
- Green public procurement
 criteria



Whole life cycle GHG emissions

- Level(s) framework for sustainable buildings
- 2050 roadmap for whole life cycle emissions (Renovation Wave)
- Energy Performance of Buildings Directive: Art. 7 New buildings
- Energy Efficiency Directive: Arts 6 & 7
- Construction Products Regulation







Construction Products Regulation (CPR)



- Lays down EU-wide rules for marketing construction products
- Undergoing revision to:
 - Improve functioning of single market for construction products
 - Integrate sustainability requirements

- Higher energy efficiency target 9 > 13%
- Higher renewables target 40 > 45%
- Solar Rooftop Initiative
- Doubling heat pump deployment: 10 million next 5 years, 30 million by 2030
- Accelerated permitting (<3 months for solar on buildings), define 'renewables go-to areas'

- Pact for Skills (launched 2020) promotes joint action for upskilling & reskilling
- Signatories of the Pact sign up to a Charter, make commitments
- Skills partnership for construction (Feb 2022): energy efficiency, circular economy, digitalisation
- Upskill & reskill 25% of workforce in 5 years



Co-creating a transition pathway

- The Commission is co-creating transition pathway towards a green, digital and resilient construction ecosystem
- High Level Construction Forum
- Staff Working Document proposed scenarios for transition pathway
- Transition Pathway currently being drafted





EU Taxonomy for sustainable activities

- Objective: direct investments towards
 "sustainable" projects
- Climate Change Adaptation & Mitigation (in force since January 2022)
- Water, Biodiversity, Pollution, Circular Economy (under development)

- Horizon Europe (EUR 95.5 billion)
- Cluster 4 Digital, Industry & Space
- **Cluster 5** Climate, Energy & Mobility (including Built4People partnership)
- **Cluster 6** Food, Bioeconomy, Natural Resources, Agriculture & Environment
